64.01 AUTHORITY TO MARK. The Police Chief may cause markers, buttons or signs to be placed within or adjacent to intersections and thereby require and direct, as traffic conditions require, that a different course from that specified by the State law be traveled by vehicles turning at intersections, and when markers, buttons or signs are so placed, no driver of a vehicle shall turn a vehicle at an intersection other than as directed and required by such markers, buttons or signs.

64.02 U-TURNS. It is unlawful for a driver to make a U-turn except at an intersection, provided, however, U-turns are prohibited at intersections within the business district, and at intersections where there are automatic traffic signals or posted “No U-turns” signs.

64.03 AUTHORITY TO RESTRICT TURNS. The Police Chief is hereby authorized to determine those intersections, as traffic conditions require, at which the drivers of vehicles shall not make a right or left turn. The making of such turns may be prohibited between certain hours of any day, in which event the same shall be plainly indicated on signs. Whenever authorized signs are erected that no right or left turn is permitted, no driver of a vehicle shall disobey the directions of any such signs.
